



Shear Genius Salon's Mandatory Guidelines

(For everyone's safety during the Covid-19 Pandemic)

No Waiting Areas

- Unfortunately, waiting rooms have become a thing of the past. **Clients will wait in their car and call us when they arrive**, and we will let you know when your stylist is available, and their station has been sanitized. Aside from shampoos, all services will take place at one station.

Upon entering the salon

- All clients must come with **clean dry hair**
- Clients must wear a **face mask over their nose and mouth at all times**.
- Face masks must be of behind the ear design. No behind the head attachments, scarves or bandannas will not be allowed.
- When you enter the salon, **we will take your temperature**. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will have to reschedule.
- Clients will then **go to our sanitizing station to sanitize their hands** and then proceed to their stylist's chair.
- As per recommendations from the CDC, no one will be allowed into the salon wearing gloves.
- Clients are urged to remain in their stylist's chair to reduce touch points around the salon.
- If you have traveled outside of the country, and this is particularly true for our brave flight attendants, we ask that you wait two weeks before coming to see us.

One Person Per Appointment

- State mandates that no one accompanies you to your appointment. Friends and kids may not be with you.
- The only exception will be child haircuts, and we ask the parents not to approach the station while the service is being performed.

No Personal Items

- We are asking you to limit your items to your cell phone, keys form of payment and bottle of water if you would like. No handbags or food please. Coats and umbrellas will remain with you during your service.

PPE and Regulations

- Stylist will wear a face mask and shields at all times. All stations are 7 feet apart. High contact areas and bathrooms will be sanitized frequently. There is a physical barrier between the sinks.

Sanitization

- All tools will be sanitized, and towels, capes and robes kept in a closed container. Stylist stations will be sanitized between each client. (This will be taking the stylists additional time between clients.)

No Blow Drying

- In the state of Connecticut, blow-dries are forbidden. This includes self-blow drying.

Amenities

- No complementary beverages will be served.
- You may bring a water bottle with you.

No Changing Rooms

- You will receive a protective smock (if getting color) at the front door. Please be mindful of the shirt you wear as you will not be able to take it off.

Tipping

- All cash tips should be placed in envelopes provided, to be opened at a later date. Cash or Personal check only.

Product Sales

- If you need to purchase products, please ask your stylist or receptionist for assistance. We want to avoid handling of the product displays.

Social Distancing

- We ask that you continue to be mindful of physical contact, distance, and placement of your personal items.
